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Term: Meningitis

Meningitis: A very serious infection that is caused by inflammation to the membranes that surround the brain and spinal cord.

This infection can be caused by many kinds of bacteria and/or viruses. It often appears very suddenly and can include high fevers, stiff neck, and vomiting.

Since the Premie cannot alert you to these symptoms they are often subjected to spinal taps to



make sure there is no infection brewing. This procedure is necessary because meningitis can be fatal if not treated properly and quickly.

Questions for the Doctors:

1. What treatment is being provided for my baby?
2. What can I do to help my baby at this time?
3. What do you believe is the long-term prognosis for my baby?
4. Are there any side effects from this treatment?
5. Will any follow-up be needed because of this treatment?

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
