## Term: Seizure

#### Seizure:

When the brain cannot control certain electrical activity. There are many different types of seizures, including those caused by a disrupted nervous system, fevers, birth defects, and oxygen deficits. These can be as extreme as huge physical convulsions or as mild as minor physical disturbances. While over 50% of seizures are unidentifiable, there are many medications that they can give your baby to help



resolve and decrease the seizure activity.

Nicole's Take: We didn't even realize Nicholas had what we now refer to as an "undiagnosed seizure disorder," until well after we were home. And then we discovered he simply could not function when we tried to remove his Phenobarbital and Clonapin. But with both of these medications, whatever seizure disorder he is experiencing is kept under control.



## PETITION: New RSV Petition Citing Research Discrepancies

With the recent stressors surrounding the new Synagis (palivizumab) guidelines, professionals have launched a new petition to the AAP citing research discrepancies. Authors Ram Yogev, Lenny Krilov, Lenny Weiner and Jaime Fergie created this under the name Physicans and Other Professionals Urging Logical Approach to RSV (POPULAR). We asked Ram Yogev for a summary of this petition.

#### What is the essence of this petition?

As a group of healthcare professionals involved in the RSV prevention trials and caring for these infants, we believe that the most recent recommendations from the COID for increasing restriction of palivizumab use

in prematures (i.e. only for prematures with gestational age <29 weeks) merit further discussion and analysis as the data used to develop the recommendations seem to be incomplete or misinterpreted. Discussions with the AAP have been unsuccessful. We also found at least one agency that supposedly supported the new recommendations but in reality did not. Many of our healthcare colleagues support our request to re-evaluate the recommendations.
