

Parent Tips for Pros: Int'l Kangaroo Care Awareness Day

Nurtured by Design, Inc. came about when Founder Yamile Jackson, Ph.D., PE, PMP had a premature infant and wanted a way to be with her son during the NICU stay. 12 years later, Yamile sponsors "International Kangaroo Care Awareness Day."

Q: *How did this special day come about?*

When my son Zachary was in the NICU in 2001 I kangaroo'ed him for 5-7 hours every day. Today, regardless of all of the science behind KC parents are not kangaroo'ing their babies nearly that much. So the day is to raise awareness and educate everyone on the lifelong benefits of Kangaroo Care for babies in NICUs and postpartum. *Q: What do you want professionals to know about KC? A:* Kangaroo Care is natural, effective, and it reduces the cost of healthcare. It does not happen by chance or by learning how to transfer a baby; it requires a systematic approach for implementation, education, tools, and continuous improvement.
