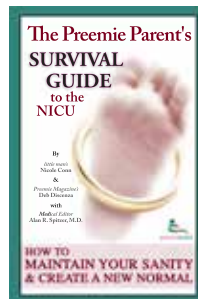
Cerebral Palsy (CP)

Cerebral Palsy (CP): A muscle and coordination disorder caused by some form of neurological (brain) injury before, during, or after birth. There are several varieties of CP (see the infographic in our *Preemie Freebie* section on page 1) and many are not obvious for a number of years. While this diagnosis can be devastating, it is important to note that there is extensive research on management of this disorder. Many people go on to have very productive lives with CP.

Questions to Ask the Doctor:

- Based on my child's unique situation, what are the chances of him/her having Cerebral Palsy?
- What type of therapies will we go home with from the NICU to help our child since CP is a common diagnosis with premature birth?

AFTER THE NICU:

Cerebral Palsy Diagnosis

With Cerebral Palsy (CP) being a huge concern with preemie parents, do not assume that your doctor will be the person to pick up on the most subtle of signs. You are the key person as you see everything and are the connecting point between professionals. Keep notes and share them with your team ongoing:

- Pediatrician
- Neurologist
- Early Intervention Therapist (PT, OT, Speech, etc.)
- Orthopedic Surgeon
- Developmental Pediatrician

And know that a second opinion is your right.
