
Gram

Gram: The metric unit of weight used in the hospital to weigh babies. 1,000 grams equal a kilogram which is roughly 2.25 pounds. And for you math geeks out there with pocket calculators, 1 gram=0.0022046 pounds.

Note: Weight is a significant factor in taking care of preemies as both a sense of progress and a factor in medicating. You may hear the term "dry weight" being used during rounds. This is what the doctors consider to be the more accurate weight of your baby than what he may actually show on the scale, since many babies retain fluid during their illness.


