
TERM:

Kangaroo Care (also Kangaroo Mother Care)

Kangaroo Care: Kangaroo Care is a wonderful way to connect with your baby and give him or her the amazing comfort and stability of health. This procedure involves placing your diaper-only baby (plus leads, etc.) on your chest. Your baby hears your heartbeat and feels your body temperature. Quickly you notice that the monitor shows your baby's stats improving and that your baby is much more peaceful and can fall into a very deep slumber. This is something that both moms and dads can do (though dads need to be prepared for a little chest hair pulling).


Coloring Book: Rich & Creamy for Our Preemie

How do they get comfort and the ability to process this situation in a healthy and developmentally appropriate manner?

Each page goes through the story of a young child going through the arrival of a preemie sibling and the journey from NICU to home and within that, learning about how breast-milk helps the infant.







AFTER THE NICU:

Go or Not Go? Someone Else's Baby Shower

Your baby is home from the NICU and you are settled into life and trying to move on. But then you get an invitation to a good friend's baby shower. Do you go or not go? You want to support your friend it feels awkward and anxiety-inducing, yes? Tips:

- *Talk to your friend.* Be honest and explain that you want to support her but the situation is awkward for you and common for preemie parents.
- *Pre-shower!* Suggest a "Pre-Baby Shower" at an alternative date and time so you two can hang out together and just talk, eat a meal and relax.
- Have a buddy system. If you do go, ask a friend there to check in on you, protect you from invasive questions and scoot you as soon as the party is over.
