Postpartum Depression & PTSD

Postpartum Depression (PPD): Many new mothers get this type of depression (also known as the "baby blues") after delivery or the first few months thereafter. Rather than the joys of having a newborn, the mother is depressed, crying, and often distant from her infant. So add that to a new Preemie Mom and all of the medical barriers and it is a no-brainer that this has become so common in the NICU.

Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD): PTSD happens to anyone who has experienced a traumatic situation either short term or long-term. Triggers can happen day or night, asleep or awake. Like PPD, it is important to speak to a professional and gain support from family and friends. You are not being a drama queen or king; you have had the shock of your life.

Fact: Moms and Dads are at risk for both PPD and PTSD.


