After the NICU: RSV & Synagis

Parents are often behind the eight ball when getting ready for Respiratory Syncytial Virus season. Here are some quick reminders:

- o Talk to the doctor <u>now</u> about precautions needed this season.
- o Call/Meet with the pediatrician or specialist's office now to work on a pre-approval of Synagis from insurance so as to not miss doses due to "red tape."
- Prepare family and friends now regarding visitation and more.
- Get those doctors appointments for the family done now to avoid unnecessary outings.
- Look at ways to get through isolation: books, videos, Skype chats with others, etc.


