THIS MONTH'S TERM: BRAIN BLEED


Brain Bleed (IVH or Intraventricular Hemorrhage):

The blood vessels in your baby's brain can bleed rather easily, even when the infant is moving in some cases. There are generally 4 levels of brain bleeds (from 1 to 4). Grade 4 is the most serious and can be the source of seizures, blindness and severe retardation. The doctors normally scan for brain bleeds within the first 24 hours (the most critical), then after three days, and then after one week. The chances of a brain bleed one week are dramatically decreased. Often they will do a final brain bleed check at week six.

Questions to Ask the Doctor

- **✓** What stage is the bleed?
- What can be done medically or what can I do to help at this point?
- What are the longterm outcomes for this stage of a brain bleed?
- ✓ Is there anything else I should know?




