

ORG: BRADY'S BRIDGE

Brady's Bridge was begun by **Tabitha Fry** and her husband with simply a desire to provide support and resources to families of kids with special needs. The birth of their son, Brady, in 2011, opened their eyes to a new world of diagnoses, therapies, medical claims and more. It was a challenging time that only increased when Brady entered Kindergarten in 2016: there was not an after school care programs that would be able to accommodate Brady's numerous needs with a feeding tube and several diagnoses that included a seizure disorder. These programs, on average, staff 1 adult to 18 kids and they could not provide the individualized care that he required. So the Frys decided to raise money to fund their own after school care program. Their current goal is \$50,000 by the end of June 2018 so that the specialized care can start in August of 2018. Why so expensive? There is a reason the adult to child ratios were so high with other programs, they had to be able to pay their people and still cover their operational costs. So a lower ratio of adult to students is not normally feasible. That is why Brady's Bridge exists.



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BOOK: ONE OF TWO

Author Ali Dunn (I Was A Preemie Just Like You) has come out with her second book via her publishing company, Me Two Books, One of Two: A Twin Story About Individuality.

Aptly titled, the book delves into a fresh topic that numerous parents of twins are likely to confront at one point in the childrens' journey: being one's own self. With twins there is naturally a curiosity but also a misguided expectation that, identical or not, are simply entire carbon copies of each other.

In **One of Two** this is played out in the form of two adorable ewes that look alike but couldn't be more different. Add in a whole host of farmyard animals and you have a fun book for bedside at the NICU, at home and all the way into the preschool years.
